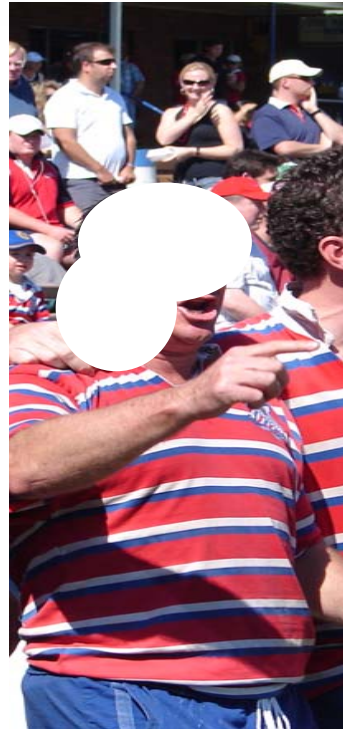

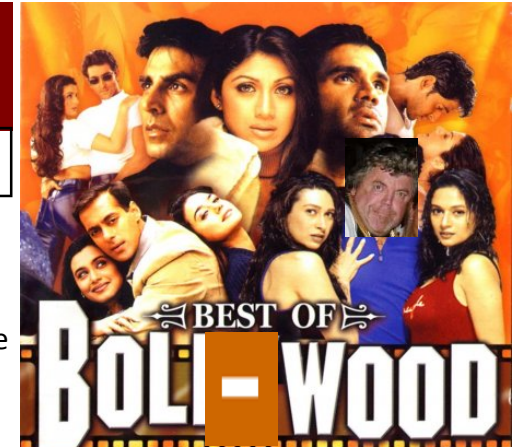
Old Ignatians 3 v Mosman 6
